- Transforming underutilized space into an *Early Learning Area* for education and recreation for *children age birth to five and their parents* or caregivers
- Creating *a suitable space for teen programming*, which will double as an *attractive meeting room for community groups*
- Upgrading the HVAC system for *improved air quality*
- Enhancing the entire Children's Library with a *raised ceiling, carpet, paint, improved lighting, some new furnishings, and more*.

Construction will begin in early 2024 and conclude with a grand reopening of Children's Library in late Spring 2024.
